Terminology

Here are some terms you need to be familiar with that we will be using throughout this book:

YHWH: In Hebrew the Set Apart name is composed of four letters יהוה pronounced as;

Yud, Hei π, Vav , Hei π.

This is referred to as the "Tetragram" or "Tetragrammaton" meaning roughly, "The Four Letters."

There is no general consensus among scholars on how the Tetragram is actually pronounced.

Current research indicates five probable pronunciations for the Set-Apart Name:

- 1) Yah-way
- 2) Yah-hoo-way
- 3) Yah-oo-ay
- 4) Yah-oo-ah
- 5) Yeh-ho-vah

For this reason, the English version of the Tetragram "YHWH" is employed throughout this book to allow the reader to follow his or her own conviction on the pronunciation of the Sacred Name.

LORD or **Lord**: These terms, as used in English Bible translations, are substitutes for the Tetragram.

Yeshua: This is the eternal name of the Son who, in Christianity, is called Jesus.

Ruach haKodesh: This is the eternal name of the Set-Apart Spirit of the Father who, in Christianity, is called the Holy Spirit.

Kahal: The Hebrew name for congregation or assembly or what Christianity calls the Church.

Elohim: This is translated in our English Bibles as God.

Eloah: The singular of Elohim.

immortal creation made in the likeness of its Creator. The soul is without sin possessing perfectly free will.

We may never meet in person because circumstances may not allow us to meet but don't let that stop you from contacting us when you come across something in the book that you are unsure of because I would rather have you understand than continue with that uncertainty. I will not avoid your question or argue with you but will do my best to answer you with what I know, and if I don't know the answer you seek, I will tell you so.

Interlude

The belief in eternal life is prevalent in every culture, society, and religion. At its core, it is a belief that is based on faith and what is based on the unseen is a mystery. Man believes that the idea of living forever belongs to the domain of the gods and man thinks he has been created for its attainment. It would seem that to uncover the secret of living forever would be to unlock the door to godship itself. The endless pursuit of secret knowledge and the spiritual power that will open this door has birthed many secret societies that believe that they have found the answer or source and that they are the keepers of the divine secret. Many secret books are known to have been written that only the select may read and understand. Rites, rituals, and secret passwords are known only to the initiates who must prove themselves worthy of the great secret. To divulge the content of the secret meant certain death. This secret has been kept under lock and key for eons, and today you will learn of it in this book.

Christianity, the largest religion in the world, does not teach that there is a secret to everlasting life but instead requires converts to prove themselves worthy of what they deem a free gift. Since the day of Jesus Christ, everlasting life has been marketed in every generation as an "afterlife insurance policy" so to speak that one needs to "take out" before departing Earth. The ominous conditions include one's profession of belief in his death and resurrection and not to mention, becoming a member of the Church. In his name all of mankind can be "saved" except for those who have died that did not hear of Jesus, they will be judged on the merit of their own good works. So for the Jew and the Gentile, their fate must await the final judgment, while the sinner no matter what manner of evil they had committed even in their last moments, should they ask for forgiveness from Jesus can obtain a "free pass" to Heaven. This is not what the real Messiah taught.

I am a Hebrew priest by occupation. My calling requires me to make an essential distinction, one that you will see throughout this book. The Jesus I used to understand as the savior that is espoused by Christianity as the redeemer of the world is not the same person as the Hebrew Yeshua.

My conclusion comes from years of studying Aramaic and Hebrew manuscripts and Church history. What the Hebrew Yeshua taught in respect of salvation is the dire opposite of what the Greek Jesus taught his followers. Thus, what developed in history is a dichotomy of opposing and indeed competing theologies where the eternal life model that is taught by the Church which is called "grace" had emerged as the sole winner in the fifth Century C.E. The competing model which I have termed "regeneration" in turn was systematically and methodologically removed from Church history. Its teachings were relegated to the domain of the "initiated" elect.

This may come as a surprise to you, but there is actually no secret at all and, for that matter, no mystery as well. Eternal life has always been with us from the beginning and not as what religion has deceitfully caused us to work for, and it is not in the exclusive domain of the initiated few. We were created to exist forever - a profound truth that was known to the sages of Israel and to the founder of the Messianic and Christian faith, Yeshua, who taught its tenets. The secret of the mystery is not in living forever but in understanding the mysterious WHY of life. Every human being will at one time in their life ask these questions - Who am I and where have I come from? Why am I here? Why are some people born into poverty and others born into riches? Why does this person succeed and the other fail in life? Then there are the difficult questions; Why the death of young children, stillbirths, the birth of babies with physical deformities, sudden deaths, accidents, or the suffering of those who fight prolonged battles with terminal illnesses, and so forth? These are the issues that have baffled mankind for eons, and the cloud of darkness will be lifted with this book.

I am the bearer of good news and what you will learn from me in this book will put the critical piece of the puzzle of eternal life back into your being from where it was stolen through misguided religious teachings and evangelism. Even if you are an atheist or agnostic, it really does not matter because somewhere along your journey and experience you too lost this coveted understanding. Therefore, life for all of us has become an elongated quest to discover "the way back home," drawn by an innate desire for this truth, a desire which cannot be quenched with religion or intellectualism because it is part of our human experience as prodigal sons. We have all turned each one to his own way and embraced the wisdom of this world, which has carried us away from the light of our Creator. The wisdom of God is not found in books and libraries but in understanding the book of nature. When God created man, He created man from the Earth.

Man has been disconnected from nature since we learned how to harm other living beings and living things. Human education, development, and war have etched a belief into our ethos, and psyche that we are above

creation, that we are the masters of the Earth and our own destiny, unanswerable to no one including God. Man is no-longer emotionally stirred by the perils and sufferings of living things whose cries are getting ever louder by the decades as we rapidly head towards the end of the age. The pure and innocent voices of creation have been silenced by a seared conscience and the gratification of the human desire. The greed and violence of mankind have surpassed the days of Noah. This is the reason why we have lost this wisdom. You will recover it in this book not because we deserve it, in fact, we are undeserving of it, but because we are part of the terminal generation that needs to know this information and this may be the only hope we have left!

We exist at a time in history when our planet is under the siege of corporatization and globalization whose god is money, power, and fame. Its insatiable lust will not abate until it has enslaved the entire human race with debt and poverty. Statistics show that one percent of the world's population owns forty percent of the wealth of this planet whereas fifty percent live on two dollars (\$2) a day. A convergence is coming in human history with the unfolding of the majesty of the Kingdom of God not as a spiritual entity but as a physical reality. It is unlike anything you have read about or heard via the grapevine. It is better than any paradise story you have been taught. To be a participant in the Kingdom, we must be armed with the understanding of regeneration. However, only those who choose the enlightenment of regeneration will enter the Kingdom and taste its glory. Be aware though, that it is not an easy transition because religion and materialism will oppose you. Chapter One:

Possibilities

The soul is an immortal creation. At one stage in the academic arena, we had only the religious texts to substantiate this idea but today science itself is proving the phenomenon to be true. It was about 2010 that I first came to understand the dynamics of the soul, which allowed me to discover the mystery of regeneration that had eluded my thinking because of my Christian religious background. About eight years earlier I started this journey, motivated by my desire to understand the real Messiah. My search took me to the religion of Judaism. As I searched the vast collection of Jewish writings, I came across a library of knowledge called the *Kabbalah*, which I will introduce in this book that explained the hidden meaning of texts in the Scripture of which I only had a literal understanding.

In the course of this adventure, I learned Biblical Hebrew and studied Aramaic. Armed with this knowledge, I started to write many books for No Mans Zone which have been published. It was during this mindset transition from Greek to Hebrew that I came to understand the Jewish concept of *gilgul* - in short, the Jewish idea of reincarnation. A similar understanding exists in Muslim texts. The idea here briefly is that life is a cycle of births and deaths and every human passes through cycles of birth and death. We don't have to look far to see that this is a reality in nature and the Universe. Indeed everything in the Universe and Nature is running and returning, ebbing and flowing, dying and being reborn anew.

According to Jewish *Kabbalah*, the soul is eternal and does not die when the body dies - very much the same belief that Christians have about the spirit. The difference here is that the Jews believe that the soul returns again and again until it arrives at its point of rectification, which they express in the term *Tikkun* - a concept that I will elaborate on later. This sounds like reincarnation, but the two concepts are not exactly the same. Reincarnation teaches that the human soul can descend or ascend to an upper or lower life-form, respectively, or it can be split into

different parts (emotions, will, intellect, etc.) depending on what part of your soul requires repair. On the other hand, regeneration teaches that you can only return as a whole - as another human being. Technically this is called transmigration which is the Jewish idea of ha'ataka.

The Jewish concept of reincarnation has a prestigious and elongated history of Rabbinic teaching which I will explain in Chapter 5 (Jewish). Transmigration means that a particular soul dies and then returns, intact in a subsequent lifetime in another body. In the discipline of Psychology, it is called *metempsychosis*. I prefer to view and call this process regeneration and will be referred to in this light unless I am making a distinction between the two concepts or quoting someone else's work or idea. While I am at the beginning of this book, I want to make this clear that this book is not about *Kabbalah* or reincarnation. Frankly speaking, I don't believe in the concept of reincarnation that the Hindu religion teaches and I don't accept everything that the kabbalists teach. I have a unique position that will be illuminated in this work.

If you are a Christian, you may be thinking, "this is already sounding too 'Eastern' for me and is not in the Bible" - but as you will soon learn, not only is it in the Bible, but the Church fathers taught it for centuries! It was Emperor Justinian who at the second Church Council of Constantinople in 553 C.E. officially removed all references to reincarnation (regeneration) from the New Testament. Regeneration was the belief system of the Christians before the Church began to change the system in the third century and later banned it from its tenure of belief in the fifth century C.E. It was an integral part of the teaching of Messiah Yeshua and His words were recorded in many books that were confiscated by the Catholic Church and hidden for 1800 years. This will be explained in Chapter 6 (Church). The secular and scientific evidence for regeneration is well established. Not surprisingly Atheists and Agnostics find this belief much more palatable than the traditional idea of heaven and hell. It is estimated that there are about one billion Atheists and Agnostics in the world.

The difficult-to-ignore fact is that ninety percent of the world's active religions believe in one form or another of reincarnation. Judaism, Hinduism, Buddhism, and Yahwehnism have reincarnation as their fundamental base doctrine and, to a lesser extent, the Muslim faith as well. The Sufi and other Muslim sects teach *Rajat*, literally going up and down in a cyclic fashion but not a single mainstream Christian denomination today teaches regeneration as a belief, yet it is apparent everywhere in the Scriptures as you will soon discover. Another piece of interesting statistic states that sixty percent of the world's population believes in some form of reincarnation. Today approximately 30 million Americans (one in four) believe in reincarnation, and the number

continues to grow. Whether you consider yourself to be religious or an atheist, sooner or later the truths that you will learn in this book will knock at your door. How much better than you learn the original teaching and belief?

We know for a fact that an impressive amount of data has been collected by Universities, researchers, child psychologists, and past life therapists on near-death experiences and past life memories providing evidence that is clear and convincing to any open mind, showing that life continues after death. The internet is proliferated with stories of this kind, and it would be hard to dispute that the phenomenon exists. In Chapter 7 (Science) you will be able to read some of these stories and check them out for yourself. The standard Christian apologetic against past life memories and hypnotic regression argues that these are explainable as demonic possession by disembodied spirits. How easy it is to label as "demonic" everything that conflicts with our religious theology. I cannot imagine today where I would be if I had not conquered this mindset and decided to venture beyond the texts of Christianity, which had kept me in a cocoon for decades.

It took me three years to work out how this surprisingly simple system works and where it is heading in the epochs of time. I searched for every available teaching on the subject and combed the Scriptures for understanding. What I discovered changed my life! My discovery has radically transformed my understanding of life and raised my admiration of my Creator to soar heights. Death is no longer something mysterious or to be feared but the very door to re-birth. However, I had one major gap in the system that I could not work out. If I was returning to this Earth to relive my life again and again, why can't I know who I was before, and who I will be in my next life? If one can journey into the past, then there is no reason at all why we cannot journey into the future, since life is one linear and elongated journey.

After all, this is the very knowledge on which Tibetan Buddhists identify their succession of Dalai Lamas or Chief Lamas. It is an accepted fact among Tibetan society that the present Dalai Lama is the fourteenth reincarnation of the original Dalai Lama and they found him when he was about two years old. The fact that you can discover your past life and your next life should not be in the domain of an exclusive club only. It must be for all people if it is truly from YHWH. It dawned on me one day as I was meditating on this truly profound system that this is the secret of eternal life —the answer to the ultimate quest of mankind to find eternal life. It was all around me in nature, in creation, and in every human being, but I could not see its simple truth, because I was looking for something out of this world, in the domain of faith as religion had

taught me in my formative years under Christianity. Here is the secret of regeneration in a nutshell:

The knowledge of knowing who you were (past) and who you will be reborn as (future) is eternal life (present)! This is premised upon the scientific truth that we were created to exist forever.

The day I discovered this simple truth I jumped for joy when its first rays of enlightenment hit my soul, and I knew I had to investigate this truth with all my might, and it would be what would eventually define me and my ministry. The problem that I faced was linking this truth to a scientific law. How can you explain to a modern mind today that is highly educated that regeneration is a fact unless you can establish it by a scientific principle? In a companion book titled *The Breach Maker Series 800*, there is a technical aspect to this teaching which is explained in this book; I explained the science behind regeneration in these words:

"WE WERE CREATED TO EXIST FOREVER. The reason is simple: At the core of our make-up, we are ENERGY. The first law of thermodynamics states that energy is always conserved; it cannot be created or destroyed. In actuality, energy can be converted from one form into another, but it cannot be destroyed. Energy always seeks to remain in a constant and that constant is EXISTENCE. We were created in the beginning to EXIST FOREVER because the essence of our being is taken from "the Eternal" Who has neither beginning nor end. We are an offshoot of the Creator, taken from the source that is ever-constant, non-changing, and perpetual - therefore, it is impossible for us to cease at death. Death is not to be feared but embraced as a natural part of living. All life is cyclic, and death is a natural part of that cycle.

Essentially what I am saying is that death is not real; it is a passing moment in a transition. We are already IMMORTAL BEINGS. If you can grasp this fundamental truth, then you will realize "WHAT you are" (Notice I did not say "who you are"). What you are is PURE INDESTRUCTIBLE ENERGY! At the micro atomic level, we are atoms and electrons that are constantly pulsating or vibrating at a frequency we call VISIBLE LIFE or what I have termed CORPOREAL ENERGY – bodily energy. Essentially we are sound waves pulsating at a constant waveform that becomes the likeness or expression of what we see in this natural world. For example, the waves we see in the ocean are in fact waves of energy that are pulsating through the water at a particular frequency. We cannot see the energy that is moving through the water, but we know

that with certain scientific instruments, it is measurable and that it is just as real as the physical expression itself. So are we!"

Energy is always conserved. When a physical object burns or rots, the energy, or energy configuration or information contained in that physical object is not destroyed. It merely passes on to another form. A soul is life and energy, as the Torah states, "(God) breathed into his nostrils a *nishmatchaim* (living soul)" (Genesis 2:7). What had been for me an idea or concept is now an indisputable law of nature – the Law of Regeneration. A law that I can clearly see governing all human and animal life on Earth. According to this law, we are already immortal beings with a long history of regeneration.

I was educated first as a historian and anthropologist, and these disciplines taught me that every idea, concept, and principle has a genesis in the past of humanity, no matter how seemingly new it appears. Scripture is in perfect agreement, saying, "That which has been, is that which shall be: and that which has been done, is that which shall be done, and there is nothing new under the sun" (Ecclesiastes 1:9). Thus when I began my search, I thoroughly expected the idea that we are an immortal soul that returns after death to be present in human history. In the 1st century, B.C.E., Alexander Cornelius Polyhistor the Greek scholar who became a Roman citizen and influential tutor in Rome wrote:

"The Pythagorean doctrine prevails among the Gauls' teaching that the souls of men are immortal and that after a fixed number of years, they will enter into another body."

The Pythagoreans were a Greek movement that followed the teachings of Pythagoras a Greek philosopher and mathematician whose work greatly influenced Plato and Socrates. He taught regeneration and the immortality of the soul. He was likely responsible for the spread of the belief into the British Isles well before the days of Yeshua and Christianity. The emperor Julius Caesar recorded that the Druids of Gaul, Britain, and Ireland had regeneration as one of their core doctrines and they believed that the soul is immortal:

"The principal point of their doctrine is that the soul does not die and that after death it passes from one body into another..... the main object of all education is, in their opinion, to imbue their scholars with a firm belief in the indestructibility of the human soul, which, according to their belief, merely passes at death from one tenement to another; for by such doctrine alone, they say, which robs death of all its terrors, can the highest form of human courage be developed."

The doctrine, however, goes back much further than this. The Essenes, a major religious sect that existed some 500 years before the advent of Christianity, taught this belief as a central doctrine of their faith. They were the appointed keepers of this knowledge which was presumed lost to Humanity when the Essenes were destroyed by the Roman Empire in the 3rd Century C.E. I am certain that the Essenes, being a major sect at the time, taught Pythagoras the doctrine. Throughout this book, you will find many references to the Essenes.

Most of us know that reincarnation has been taught in the East for thousands of years. Indian discussion of reincarnation enters the historical record from about the 6th century B.C.E., with the development of the *Advaita Vedanta* tradition in the early Upanishads (around the middle of the first millennium B.C.E.). There is evidence that dates the origin of the teaching of reincarnation to the Iron Age (around 1200 B.C.E.), but the greatest body of evidence of the antiquity of regeneration comes from the Bible. The doctrine is present in the Torah under the creation mandate of mankind. A connection I will thoroughly establish in this book, but for now, I want to briefly look at how the system of regeneration got started.

When our first primate Adam received a body of flesh and blood, it was created from the elements of nature, which are all impermanent and cyclic by design. This was not so at the beginning when our soul was clothed in a body of light. The fall of man inaugurated the birth and death cycles and the wickedness of man shortened the cycles. Instead of living nearly a thousand years, as was the case in the days of Methuselah and Enoch, our cycles were reduced to a mere 100 years. It is said in the Torah that YHWH was grieved that He had created man; therefore, He shortened man's life necessitating numerous regenerations within what used to be a single lifetime.

To counteract psychic amnesia – the loss of recollection of past lives that naturally came with shortened life cycles, YHWH gave mankind gifts (or anointings) to restore the loss of identity and succession that came with the shortened cycles of regeneration. What are these gifts? They are the gift of a Prophet and the gift of a Seer. Prophets and Seers in the Scriptures are claimed to have been contacted by God to speak for Him as an intermediary to humanity, delivering newfound knowledge from God to His people. The difference between the two is that while a Prophet is someone who is given knowledge of the past, the Seer is someone who is given information about the future.

Specifically, it is the job of the prophet to determine past life cycles, but it is the job of the Seer to determine the future life cycles of the people of YHWH. Generally, the Scripture according to the law of generational iniquity has set the rule, and that is up to the third and

fourth generation and no further (Exodus 34:7). The further back one journey into a person's history the more imprecise it becomes because some cycles of our lives will not be known until the Messiah returns. The Messiah is the only one who has unrestricted access to our subconscience and spirit. He alone will reveal to each person their first beginning. In fact, Judaism teaches that when the Messiah returns He will identify each person and their tribe.

Interestingly when Yeshua found His 12 *talmidim* (disciples), He knew exactly who they were and which tribe they came from. He knew they were the 12 sons of Jacob whose heads were regenerated. There is a revealing conversation that Yeshua had with Philip and Nathaniel in John 1:28. The expression "I saw you under the fig tree" in their conversation is an Aramaic expression meaning "I have always known you." For years I have wondered why Yeshua choose these seemingly insignificant men of no Torah training to be his followers until this truth was revealed to me. Truly there are no coincidences in the Kingdom of God! In fact, the word coincidence does not exist in ancient Hebrew.

The Essenes taught that through the gift of the Prophet/Seer, regeneration cycles could be determined readily. They accurately predicted the cycles of the righteous and the wicked among them and to protect this knowledge from falling into the wrong hands; they coded their predictions into horoscopes which were found among the Dead Sea Scrolls (DSS). Unfortunately, these scrolls were found in a much-deteriorated state. I will touch on these scrolls later and the information they contained. Unfortunately, we have only a fraction of the DSS available to scholars as many of the more "enlightening" scrolls were removed by the Church because they contained "sensitive" information linking the origin of Christianity to the Essene movement. There is an interesting book on this subject called *the Dead Seas Scroll Deception*.

The Essenes believed that their Master, who was also a priest (kohen) and whom they called the Teacher of Righteousness, is both a messianic and charismatic figure. They also believed that their Master possessed, from birth, the gifts which enabled him to reveal the past and present and future cycles of the members of their community. For this reason, no one would dare speak evil of him or challenge his teaching. I will explain this figure and his role in more detail in Chapter 8 (Start). The Jewish historian Josephus who lived at the time of the Essenes records that the Essenes were not afraid of death or the afterlife because they knew they would receive new bodies after death and that their Master would be there to identify their soul when it emerged from the afterlife.

Indeed in Judaism today, great Rabbis of the past are revered as being able to reveal the past of people who came to inquire of them. It is said that Jews came from everywhere to the *Arizal*, (Rabbi Isaac (ben

Solomon) Luria Ashkenazia 1534 - July 25, 1572) - a foremost Rabbi and Jewish mystic who is considered the father of Kaballah, to find out about their past lives. Similarly the *Ba'al Shem Tov* literally the master of the good name, (Rabbi Yisrael (Israel) ben Elieze died May 22, 1760) was a Jewish mystical rabbi considered to be the founder of Hasidic Judaism and is known to have revealed the past identities of Jews that besieged him for this information. These rabbis were prophets rather than seers.

In fact, in general, none of the rabbis of the past could reveal the future of their inquirers. It is not that they lacked a special virtue or power, but rather it was not in their calling, and it was not yet time for this gift of the Seer to manifest itself among the elect, as that time has been left to the end generation. It is my conclusion that we are the chosen generation that will know and benefit from the combination of these gifts and knowledge. The Prophet Daniel was among many others who possessed this unique "anointing" in his generation, but was told to shut up the book until the time of the end: "But you O Daniel, shut up the words, and seal the book - even to the time of the end. Many shall run to and fro, and knowledge shall be increased" (Daniel 12:4).

Like most of us, I am fully aware of the many so-called "prophets" in the headlines today predicting the end of the world only to be wrong again, and again. I am also well familiar with the many self-proclaimed psychics who read past lives for a fee that comes in the tens of thousands on the internet. The obvious question arises. What is the difference between these gifts? As I understand it, we are in the age of the Messiah, having previously emerged from the age of the Torah and the coming era is the age of the Kingdom. At present, we are in a transition phase, a most exciting time, where we will see certain characters mentioned in the Scriptures take center stage. These persons who are all men will operate in this anointing and will be unlike anything you have seen or heard. You will learn of their ministry in Chapter 9 (Home).

Why then is this anointing of monumental importance? To unlock the door to the next age, we must have this key in this generation! The establishment of the Kingdom of YHWH is only possible through the revelation of these gifts and the restoration of this knowledge. The prophet and Seer must begin their work before the Kingdom can manifest among men. Without this intimate understanding of who we are, where we have come from, and where we are going, man will be forever disconnected from his past, present, and future. Mankind has a greater destiny than any of us realize, and the truth of where we have come from is staggering beyond belief – a mystery that will unfold as you read the pages of this work. To get to that final revelation, we must first build our foundation and erect our structure before attaching the roof. In the words of the prophet Isaiah:

"Precept upon precept; line upon line; here a little, and there a little" (Isaiah 28:10 KJV).

Man's quest for eternal life is in understanding the law of regeneration and in the application of the gifts. In the intervening chapters of this book, I will restore and build the foundation of this knowledge as the forefathers understood and in the final chapters, I will explain why this system eventuated and demonstrate how this anointing works and reveal for the first time its laws. But first I need to define this concept of the kingdom as I have already mentioned several times in my introduction that is the goal of the system.

We all generally understand what a kingdom is from what we observe today, but there is a marked difference. In Hebrew, the word "kingdom" is described by the word "malchut" and in Greek by the word "basileia." Both Hebrew and Greek generally use the word in one of two ways; first, as the authority to rule as a king (a government), and second the realm over which the reign is exercised (a nation). Thus, the Kingdom is most simply defined is a government and nation but what type of government and nation?

The Kingdom of YHWH is a theistic government, and it is to pinpoint it accurately, the nation of Yisra'el. I use the term Yisra'el to make a clear distinction from the present Israel which is not a kingdom. Present Israel is a secular state and does not have a ruling monarch; therefore, it cannot be a theistic government. The Kingdom of God at present does not have any earthly equivalent. The only example we have of the Kingdom of YHWH was in the time of King David. Yisra'el ruled supreme over the Earth and King David its appointed sovereign ruled in conjunction with the Elders and Prophets/Seer of Yisra'el.

The Kingdom of God is an enormous topic that we explain most carefully in our book *the Kingdom Manifesto*. There are many aspects of the Kingdom that I would like to discuss here, but due to space, I will only mention one. The age of the Kingdom contrary to secular fears that it is a dictatorship, where science and reason are suppressed, and free thinking is not encouraged is not true at all. In the age of the Kingdom, the Bible, and Science will be united in their quest for truth and understanding. In our book *the Kingdom Manifesto*, we made this statement about Science and Technology in the Kingdom;

"...The Kingdom is not an enemy of Science and Technology. In the Kingdom, education will be the rule of life. Ignorance is a commodity that will not be available to its citizens because education will be universal, compulsory, and free at all levels and in all fields. All must be schooled in the basic subjects of life, the empirical and social sciences of which are

the foundation of human intellect and development. Even the topic of "God" will be studied and researched for greater understanding. Contrary to most people's assumptions about the norms of the Kingdom, no one will be forced to follow the Torah on blind faith. They must learn the truths about all religions and the journey of man. In the Kingdom superstition and lies will not hold sway over reason. Everything that is hidden will be known and open for evaluation and determination for the education of all. This might come as a shock to some but even atheists and agnostics will be allowed to co-exist alongside believers, although it would be very difficult to hold such a belief in the Kingdom for Science will come to prove the existence of YHWH. The quest of the human soul will no longer be to find the Creator but to return back to our source from whence we came. In that journey, we will colonize the stars."

What I see is the contention by people who find it difficult to accept the Theistic Kingdom where it is wrongly assumed that certain people are called to rule and not elected to rule. In YHWH's Kingdom rulers are not elected by the ballot boxes, but are chosen by YHWH according to His divine knowledge. It is the task of the Prophet and Seer to identify and train rulers in the Kingdom of God. Politics is the way of the world and is diametrically opposed to the way of the Torah because it will always boil down to rule by the majority, and when has the majority ever done the will of the YHWH? Every political system that operates on Earth today is innately corrupted. Some systems, of course, are better than others, but none have proven immune to the decay of corruption and incessable greed.

Many in the West esteem democracy as the answer to the world's problems, yet democracy today is responsible for committing some of the most atrocious crimes against life, nature, freedom, prosperity, morality, and peace. Perhaps this has not been brought to your attention before, but more human beings die or are killed under the rule of democracy than any other political system on Earth. Murder, abortion, pollution, war, industry, and commercialism to name just a few take or destroy incalculable lives and living things every year in western democracies and much of it is legal and ethical. We must make the distinction that it is Science and Technology that is what save lives and not politics and religion. I am also aware that until we have the Kingdom in place, nothing can change for the better.

The power of regeneration and these gifts are not the knowledge that we don't die, which is a fact no one can change, but it is being able to establish the rightful sovereigns of our world, and a class of rulers called "bankers" that have remained elusive to our understanding. Yeshua in the parable of talents in Mathew 25:14-30 mentions this class.

In the category of sovereigns, in the Kingdom, there will be four kings among which one is supreme and will rule over eighty-three rulers. You will learn of these later in our quest. I believe that for eon mankind has been ruled and dominated by an illegal kingdom whose ruler and banker are not the elect. There is a counterfeit elite whose purpose is to dominate and enslave mankind forever.

Imagine for a moment what this world would be like if all our divinely appointed leaders knew their divine appointments - they would achieve great things not accomplished by leaders in previous generations. Imagine again for a moment, if all our divinely appointed bankers knew their divine appointments - they would also achieve great things not accomplished by bankers in previous generations. Their decisions will bring freedom and cause capital and investment to be abundant and available. Leaders and bankers will not use their calling and gifts to increase their power and accumulate wealth, instead redistribute resources for the development of all countries and peoples.

The great potential remains undeveloped in key people because they are not able to know who they were and where they will be that will be a thing of the past. Indeed it is empowering for the soul to discover its root and its journey. The idea that fate or chance determines our future will be seen as an unrealistic condition and will be completely abandoned as were the erroneous ideas of a flat Earth and the Earth going around the sun. If God did not play dice with the creation of our Universe as Einstein observed what of the soul? Should we allow life to continue on a system of chance that promotes suffering and death or should we eliminate the probabilities by letting the elect rule?

The common situation is that a man or a woman who has worked hard all of his or her life and dies before enjoying the fruits of his or her labor or cannot continue to enjoy its benefits after death will not be permitted at the age of the Kingdom. Identity, wealth, and property will be passed down to their rightful owners/heirs because we will know regeneration cycles, routes, and trees. Titles will be bestowed upon the rightful holders because the real identity of people will be known. Thus, in the Kingdom, there will be:

- Continuity of identity (family name),
- Continuity of wealth (money, authority, and power),
- Continuity of property (inheritance),
- Continuity of family (relationships),
- Continuity of succession (rule), and
- Enlightenment (knowledge and wisdom).

I foresee a new age of enlightenment that will not be matched, an acceleration of intellect, knowledge, and wisdom that we have only faintly imagined possible. Technologies that were previously developed and restrained through commercialization and technologies that are kept secret, because of the fear that they would give "others" the edge will be released and available for all, which will, in turn, create even more astounding technological marvels. The patenting and licensing of technologies will dissipate because knowledge is no longer perceived as a commodity, but a tool for all. The universal focus of humanity will be to colonize the planets and travel the Universe.

For eons, man has had a preoccupation with extending life and mind transfer, what we call transcendence. Untold resources and billions of dollars have been invested in this pursuit with very little change. I believe that this pursuit is contrary to the cycle and call of nature and that what we really should be doing is looking at ways of improving the quality of life both morally and physically. We must let nature takes its course and accept our created condition. Our limitation is inherent in the materials from which our bodies were created and are programmed into our DNAs; thus, why we need to graciously accept our destiny to begin anew. In time we will extend lifetimes beyond the normal limit, but it will be with technology that is available to all and not a few.

Many people wonder why we can't live like it was in ancient times when man was able to live past 900 years. In the beginning, when the Earth was enveloped in a canopy of water man's life span was biologically elongated because we were shielded from the aging effects of the radiation of the Sun. Until such a time when God decides to put the water back up in the heavens where it originally belonged, we cannot elongate life to biblical time frames. As long as we live in a body of flesh, we cannot escape the conclusion of aging and death that the sun brings, although we can certainly improve the quality of our lives by eating right and living right. I will explain more about this later on in this book.

In our quest to understand our mortality, we have lost sight of the real reason why we are here. We are here at this point in time because we came from somewhere. In the journey of life, we all share the same unilateral destiny, we are all moving in the direction of a repair - a concept that is known in Judaism as *Olam ha Tikkun* (World of Repair) because we all have degenerated as a result of the fall of mankind; a fall that started with a close ancestor of man, who is not Homo erectus or the Neanderthal man. Later we shall learn of this close cousin and how his actions started this process of regeneration, and you can eliminate Adam as a first cause. Adam was, in fact, a righteous man.

It is recorded in *the Book of Adam and Eve* that when Adam ate of the forbidden fruit, he was grieved to the soul with what he had done

and so earnestly sort YHWH for forgiveness, but he could not turn the clock back because the fall was in the plan of YHWH. As strange as it may sound now, the fall of Adam had a far greater redemptive purpose than any of us had previously understood. It includes the redemption of angelic beings and the Universe – the macro purpose of regeneration. On a personal level, each of us must realize that in the great economy of souls, our awesome Creator is love and He desires that no one perishes – the micro purpose of regeneration. This is His unchangeable will for every human being as revealed in 2 Samuel 14:14 which states that "…neither does God take away life but devises mean that none is lost to Him."

Our disconnection from the Set Apart One (YHWH) occurred when we all turned to our own ways and forgot about our Creator and our responsibility to our fellow man. When the focus of life is turned upon self, and upon material gain, we lost our way in this immense and beautiful Universe that is our common inheritance. At the climax of humanity, there will be an end to the cycle of birth and death that is determined upon all of the descendants of Adam. At the end of the epoch of the Kingdom – the beginning of the renewed Earth, death our final enemy will be destroyed. To become worthy of the great gift of Eternal Life wherein we cannot die again; we must all travel the road of regeneration and pass the test of life. I tell you that no priest, prophet, or even the Messiah is exempt from this pathway when clothed with flesh. Once we enter this world we will die.

I may have released a bombshell that has shattered your world or perhaps I have just tickled your fancy, but whatever it may be, the next chapter will certainly put things into their proper perspective for you. For every idea or concept, we need to understand the thoughts behind it to make sense of the whole. Regeneration is no exception. In the next chapter we will look at the reasons for regeneration but first here is a summary of the main points of this chapter.

A SUMMARY OF THE MAIN POINTS

- 1. All life and nature run in cycles and human beings are no exception.

Chapter Two:

Purpose

Everything under the sun has a purpose, and some things have more purposes or reasons for existence than others. Regeneration is one of those things that have multiple purposes. I loosely mentioned some of these purposes in my introduction, but in this chapter, you will see some of the "special reasons" why YHWH designed the system. I must admit that in the process of collecting these special reasons, I am so thankful to My Creator for not allowing the doctrines of religion to determine the end of my soul. Having learned these reasons, I believe that regeneration is the only effective antidote we have against the power of religion which has always sought to enslave mankind under the traditions of men.

In understanding the purposes of regeneration, you will experience the logic and the wisdom of God. These purposes do not change from one generation to the next; as long as there are human beings with physical bodies, regeneration will remain a fact of existence, and I do not see the system changing any time soon. It is the law of Nature.

PURPOSES OF REGENERATION

First, regeneration allows a continuation of the soul's journey on Earth

With the fall of mankind came the need for perpetual regeneration. The fall of mankind, however, did not start with Adam and Chavah (Eve) - it began in the celestial Kingdom of God. In Chapter 8 (Start), the fall will be discussed in some detail; therefore; I will not discuss it at great length here. Instead, we will just look at the properties of the soul and the development of the concept of the pre-existence of the soul that is the backbone of this system.

Philosophically, the existence or pre-existence of the soul before or after death is a subject of on-going debate. The opinions that have been put forward are varied: some believe that the soul is a separate entity from the spirit, others argue that it pre-exists in the spirit, and still,

others believe that it does not exist. An excellent article from the Wiki Encyclopaedia provides the background on the development of the concept of the pre-existence of the human soul as follows:

- Plato, drawing on the words of his teacher Socrates, considered the soul as the essence of a person, being that which decides how we behave. He considered this essence to be an incorporeal, eternal occupant of our being. As bodies die, the soul is continually reborn in subsequent bodies.
- Aristotle defined the soul or psyche (ψυχή) as the first actuality of a naturally organized body but argued against it having a separate existence from the physical body. In Aristotle's view, the primary activity of a living thing constitutes its soul; for example, the soul of an eye, if it were an independent organism, would be seeing as this is its purpose or final cause.
- Following Aristotle, the Persian Muslim philosopher-physician, Avicenna (Ibn Sina) and Arab philosopher Ibn al-Nafis, further elaborated on the Aristotelian understanding of the soul and developed their own theories regarding the soul. They both made a distinction between the soul and the spirit, and in particular, the Avicennian doctrine regarding the nature of the soul was influential among the Scholastics. Some of Avicenna's views on the soul included the idea that the immortality of the soul is a consequence of its nature and not a purpose for it to fulfill. In his theory of "The Ten Intellects," he viewed the human soul as the tenth and final intellect.
- Following Aristotle and Avicenna, St. Thomas Aquinas understood the soul to be the first actuality of the living body. Consequent to this, he distinguished three orders of life -plants, which feed and grow; animals, which add sensation to the operations of plants; and humans, which add intellect to the operations of animals.
- In his discussions of rational psychology, Immanuel Kant (1724–1804) identified the soul as the "I" in the strictest sense and argued that the existence of inner experience could neither be proved nor disproved.
- Contemporary psychology is defined as the study of mental processes and behavior. However, the word "psychology" literally means "study of the soul," and psychologist James Hillman, the founder of archetypal psychology, has been credited with "restoring 'soul' to its psychological sense." Although the words soul and spirit are

often viewed as synonyms, Hillman argues that they can refer to antagonistic components of a person. Summarizing Hillman's views, author and psychotherapist Thomas Moore associates spirit with "afterlife, cosmic issues, idealistic values and hopes, and universal truths", while placing the soul "in the thick of things: in the repressed, in the shadow, in the messes of life, in illness, and in the pain and confusion of love."

It can be surmised from the above that through the ages, man has always understood the soul to be the immortal part of his being. Arguably the soul is sometimes referred to as the spirit of man, but the distinction is a moot point. Regeneration in effect allows for the continuation of the soul's journey in this physical world. Therefore, the destiny of the soul so to speak is not "up or down" but to be here on Earth for a time in which YHWH has determined the restoration, enlightenment, and advancement of the soul. This is linked to the Jewish concept that every soul has a mission to accomplish.

Second, regeneration continually advances the evolution of the mind

I am convinced through the evidence brought forth by Creation Scientists that physical evolution is a non-reality. Instead what we have in nature is simply the adaptation of species for survival. While I am not a proponent of evolution in general, I will concede that human beings are evolving in mental capacity and ability. As man regenerates, his mental capacity and ability evolve. Human beings are getting smarter and smarter like never before. Thus, why with every new generation, there is an exponential growth of technology.

It seems like knowledge is doubling in shorter and shorter periods. Moore's law describes the rate at which human knowledge is growing, saying that computers will get twice as smart every 18-24 months - as described in the following interesting article on the subject:

"The world's knowledge is increasing at exponential rates, as is our technology. The number of text messages sent and received every day exceeds the total population of the planet. There are over 2.7 billion searches performed on Google each month. There are 3,000 new books published every single day. It is estimated that a week's worth of New York Times contains more information than a person was likely to come across in a lifetime in the 18th century. It is estimated that 40 exabytes (4.0 X 10 to the 19th power) of unique new information will be generated worldwide this year. That is more than in the previous 5,000 years. We've gone from information overload to information explosion. The technical

knowledge explosion is governed by Moore's Law, which says that computers will get twice as smart every 18-24 months. It takes four years to get a technical degree, but by the time a student graduates, his education is virtually obsolete. At this exponential rate, it's estimated that before too long, the sum total of human knowledge will double every 72 hours. The amount of new technical information is doubling every 2 years; by 2012 it is predicted to double every 72 hours. Third generation fiber optics have recently been separately tested by NEC and Alcatel...that carry 10 trillion bits per second down to a single strand of fiber....that is 1,900 CD's or 150 million phone calls every second. It is currently tripling every 6 months and is expected to do so for the next 20 years. Predictions are that by 2013 a supercomputer will be built that exceeds the computation capacity of the human brain. Predictions are by 2049; a \$1,000 computer will exceed the computational capabilities of the entire human species."

What I see happening is the same smart people who are developing and improving our technology are doing it again and again. For example, Sir Isaac Newton and Albert Einstein are far from dead - they are out there doing it again, and this time they are twice as smart and twice as knowledgeable. Of course, the converse is true of evil scientists or sorcerers who bring destruction to the Earth for personal gain. In other instances, the cause is good people ignorantly doing the wrong thing or they are deceived or forced to create evil devices.

Third, regeneration expresses the unfathomed love of YHWH

We read in the Scripture, and we are also told that "God is love" or that He loves us! For the Christians, the cross of Christ is the supreme expression of God's love, for the Jews, it is the blessed Torah of Moshe, and for the Muslims, it is the Koran that was given to them by their beloved prophet Mohammed. But how can contradictory truths be all correct? Certainly no Jew or Muslim will accept that Jesus' sacrifice on the cross is an expression of God's love - because every religion has its own revelation. The universal standard that transcends all religions is the unfathomed love of God that is expressed through regeneration. Think about this for a moment!

What kind of love is it if I only get one chance at this life? Let us be honest. How many people do you know who got it right before they died? If you are Christian how many do you know of died before receiving Jesus as their personal savior? What about if you are a Muslim and some of your family members are Hindus or atheists, and they died

as unbelievers? Can you honestly see God sending these people to an eternal lake of fire because they never got it right or received your Messiah? Every religion has these grey areas, but in regeneration, there are no grey areas because life goes on again and again until we get it right and learn about the one true God.

On a personal level, how many of us would not give opportunity after opportunity to our own child or a friend to get it right? How much more is our heavenly Father who best understands our human frailty? YHWH created human beings with the inclination to do good or evil — YHWH understands that even the best of us (including our so-called Saints) will at times submit to their evil inclination. Therefore, which of us would not offer the offender out of pure love the opportunity to repent? What about "seventy times seven" times according to the benchmark set by Yeshua?

"Then Kefa called to Him, and said, My Master: how many times will my brother sin against me, and I forgive him? Until seven times? And Yeshua said to him: I say not to you, until seven times, but until seventy times seven" (Matthew 18:21-22).

Only the unfathomed love of God can do this seemingly impossible thing. Learning how to forgive is one of the greatest *mitzvahs* (work) that a soul can learn to accomplish, one that can only be perfected over many lifetimes. To do this one needs to experience in the flesh the unfathomable love of YHWH which begins with the realization of understanding the universal role of YHWH as our one and only true Father and, as His children, the innumerable times that He has forgiven us undeservingly. The purpose of this is that one day we might also learn to do the same with others that hurt us – to forgive them and not bear a grudge when they repent.

Fourth, regeneration manifests the never-ending mercy of YHWH

I have already introduced you to the term *gilgul* which in Hebrew means "cycles within cycles." Cycles are prevalent throughout the Scripture; we have the seven-day cycle, the monthly moon cycle, the yearly feast cycle, and the Jubilee cycle - the idea here being that it is something that is set in nature that cannot be changed which is reflective of on-going mercy of YHWH. The word *gilgul* in Hebrew has the same numeric value (*Gematria*) as the Hebrew word *chesed* or loving-kindness which is translated as mercy in the Renewed Covenant. The meaning of the word shows that our Creator gives us chance after chance - a clear demonstration of his extended mercy! Thus, the basis of *gilgul* is the on-

going *chesed* or mercy of YHWH which is similar to His love we discussed in the last heading.

In Hassidic teaching, the word *gilgul* is symptomatic of rectification or fixing up. According to the Kaballah, this world is for the divine purpose of rectification to bring us to our *Tikkun* - the place of our fulfillment which has a beautiful ending, which I will leave for the end of the book. In the journey of *gilgul*, the soul is provided with countless opportunities to experience the unfathomable mercy of our Creator. In the journey of time, each one of us falls from grace into the pit and is restored numerous times. Without the mercy of YHWH, we will be permanently lost in the valley of the shadow of death, as Job realized:

"Behold, God works all these things, Twice, in fact, three times with a man, To bring back his soul from the Pit, That he may be enlightened with the light of life" (Job 33:29 NKJV).

The immutable truth is the whole of creation is dependent upon the never-ending mercy of the Creator. YHWH forbid if for one moment our great Universe were to exist without the mercy of the one who created it - it would immediately descend into chaos and death. As Job rightfully observed when the soul arrives at this place of enlightenment, it will realize that it is the mercy of YHWH that saves him or her from destruction through regeneration. The Bible teaches that the wages of sin is death (Romans 6:23), but it also teaches that YHWH is long-suffering and that none should perish (2 Peter 3:9).

Fifth, regeneration offers new lives in a new time

Life is not to determine whether we go to heaven or hell. We are given opportunity after opportunity to find the truth. We read earlier that:

"...neither does God take away life but devises mean that none is lost to Him" (2 Samuel 14:14).

Similarly, in the Renewed Covenant, Paul says;

"For this is good and acceptable before Eloah our Life-giver, Who desires that all the sons of men should have Life, and turn to the knowledge of the Truth" (1 Timothy 2:4).

The fact is many people are killed or suffer mental incapacities or are born into the wrong circumstance that prevents them from finding

their way, therefore, how can a just and loving God sentence them to everlasting damnation because their situation prevented them from finding the truth that would save them? Further, how do we know that it was not YHWH's will that prevented them from knowing the truth in which case they would be blameless even if they were pagan? In these very common cases, we can rest on the assurance that death (and regeneration) is for the preservation and not the destruction of life.

Indeed there are acts of God described in the Scripture that will baffle anyone not aware of the reality of regeneration. In Numbers 31:17 and elsewhere in reference to their enemies, YHWH commanded Israel to slay every male among the little ones and every woman that has not known a man. Why? Because through regeneration, they will be reborn again in peaceful times or environment where they could discover the truth - a clear act of mercy aimed at preserving life rather than destroying it. For years I used to struggle with why YHWH instructed Israel to kill the women and children of their enemies. I reasoned it was to ensure that those children don't grow up to become new enemies, but they could have retrained them. What puzzled me further was in those biblical days, kings usually spared the lives of the people they conquered to serve the conquerors as laborers and tax-payers, but YHWH did not want this either.

We see a similar course of action proposed by Paul in 1 Corinthians 5:5. The situation was a man had violated the Torah by sleeping with his father's wife. It appears that multiple wives were allowed in The Torah in the first Century, but notice what Paul says in this passage: "...deliver such one to Satan for the destruction of the flesh that his ruach (spirit) may be saved in Yom YHWH." (My emphasis in bold). It is an obvious reference to regeneration because no one can get saved on the Day of YHWH unless they had repented of their deeds prior to the day of God's wrath. In Paul's understanding, death (and regeneration) would provide another chance for this sinner. Most of us would consider what Pauls suggests as harsh and cruel, but in light of the truth of regeneration, Paul's suggestion is aimed at preserving life.

Sixth, regeneration exposes the wicked

Four generations ago it was difficult to identify the wicked - unless you were notoriously evil. Today the distinction between good and evil people has become ever more pronounced, and many of the wicked ones wear a suit and tie. It is not the common folks who are destroying our planet and all that dwell therein, but it is the owners of Corporations and the heads of Governments who seek power, control, and profit at

any cost to anyone or anything including our environment, and they seek to the enslave the masses in a perpetual cycle of debt and consumerism.

With this distinction in mind, the truth about regeneration becomes apparent: People are either progressing or regressing - those who are bent on doing evil are not improving, while those committed to doing good are excelling. The righteous through successive regenerations will get better, while the wicked will get worse. The Scripture indicates that the wicked are incapable of repenting. Therefore, they will continue in their cycle of doing evil until they are no more:

"Let favor be shown to the wicked, yet will he not learn righteousness: in the land of uprightness will he deal wrongfully, and will not behold the majesty of YHWH (Isaiah 26:10)."

Generally speaking, this is exactly what we see today. Those who have been doing good are starting to shine like the firmament of the heavens, and those who have been doing evil are being exposed and brought to shame. Regeneration sorts out "the tares from the wheat" and "the sheep from the goats." We also see this pattern concerning the development of science and technology. As the human mind continues to evolve, we see science being used by good people to do greater good and by evil people to do greater evil in accordance with the principle of "good begets good, and evil begets evil."

In a noteworthy parable in the Renewed Covenant Scripture, Yeshua explained this principle in the parable of the fruit tree. The relevant lesson of the parable is in the following verses:

"But by their fruits, you will recognize them. Are grape clusters gathered from thorns or figs from thistles? Even so, every good tree yields good fruit, but every bad tree yields bad fruit. A good tree cannot yield bad fruit; neither can a bad tree yield good fruit. But indeed, every tree that yields not good fruit is cut down and cast into the fire. And you, by their fruit, you will know them" (Matthew 7:15-20).

Through regeneration, we will discover the truly wicked ones (the unrepented) because by their fruits we will recognize them as Yeshua taught us (Matthew 7:16-20). Though they hide, YHWH will expose them in this lifetime or the following one; we have this Scripture to guarantee it, "For there is nothing hidden that will not be disclosed, and nothing concealed that will not be known or brought out into the open" (Luke 8:17). The age-old adage 'that you can run but not hide' seems to fit regeneration nicely.

Seventh, regeneration ensures the implementation of YHWH's perfect process of achieving justice

At one time in Yisra'el men used to believe that a father's sins were visited upon his sons. However, YHWH corrected this erroneous belief through the prophet Ezekiel as expounded in the following verses:

"And the word of YHWH came unto me, saying: What mean you, that you use this proverb in the land of Yisra'el, saying, the fathers have eaten sour grapes, and the children's teeth are set on edge? As I live, says the Adonai YHWH: You shall not have occasion anymore, to use this proverb in Yisra'el. Behold, all souls are Mine: as the soul of the father, so also the soul of the son is Mine; the soul that sins—it, shall die" (Ezekiel 18:1-4).

YHWH makes it clear that the sons do not pay for their father's sins, but each person must pay for his (or her) own sin. This clarification, by the way, is a clear scriptural proof of the reality of regeneration. Otherwise, how else can an unrepentant sinner pay for his own sin after death if he is not reborn? Many people do evil for which they do not receive their "just deserts" because they are never discovered or have passed away. If there is true justice in this Universe, then its wheels will not ground to a halt when the offender or perpetrator flees or dies.

Regeneration is a mechanism of justice that has been built into the Universe. The idea of gilgul is what goes around comes around - you sow what you reap, and you reap what you sow. It is a Jewish principle - a measure for a measure or a tooth for a tooth. Since antiquity, the laws of every righteous nation are based upon this unfailing principle — i.e., that the sinner must pay for his sin. The idea that Christ came to give us the grace to negate the law of YHWH is lawlessness.

Contrary to what has been taught, it is not possible to repent on your deathbed! This is a mockery of Scripture, which clearly teaches the principle of *Teshuvah* - a Hebrew word meaning repentance, the subject of Chapter 9 (Home) towards the end of this book. Under the requirements of *teshuvah*, you must be able to physically rectify or repair what you have done wrong. There is a process of repentance that cannot be done on a deathbed. In addition, if our sins could truly be fixed with a mere confession and apology without having to physically correct what we did wrong, then how could we possibly learn our lesson? But what if the person is incapable of repentance or has died? The answer is clear, they will return whole and able to face their sin again. Justice will be done through regeneration.

Eighth, regeneration provides for the earthly requital of justice

Every righteous or evil deed we do in the flesh deems it necessary that we are recompensed in the flesh. This is a principle of Scripture which is stated in the following:

"Behold, the righteous shall be requited in the Earth: how much more the wicked and the sinner" (Proverbs 11:31).

The words 'requited in the Earth' shows that both the good and bad have to be repaid on Earth, hence why the righteous and the wicked need to be regenerated. This is the message of another great parable that Yeshua taught - the parable of the unmerciful servant in Matthew 18. Briefly, the unmerciful servant was delivered to the torturers (human debt collectors) until he had paid his debt in the flesh here on Earth.

On the other hand, we also see the Messiah promising His disciples that they would be repaid for their services to Him on Earth and in the flesh. Notice the word "now in this time."

"Yeshua answered and said: Truly I say to you, that there is no man, who has forsaken houses, or brothers, or sisters, or father, or mother, or wife, or children, because of Me, and because of My Good News, And will not receive a hundredfold **now in this time**: houses, and brothers, and sisters, and mothers, and children, and fields, with persecution. But in the world to come, eternal life" (Mark 10:29-30). (My emphasis in bold).

However, there is an exception to this rule, the extremely wicked (those incapable of repentance, like the Watchers who left their abode and laid with the daughters of men. See the Book of Enoch). They are not reborn but are reserved for the day of destruction in the heart of the Earth unless there is a purpose for their regeneration that YHWH sees fit. The Book of Job indicates this as follows:

"That the evil man is reserved to the day of calamity; that they are led forth to the day of wrath?" (Job 21:30).

Accordingly the wicked will be reborn for *Yom YHWH* (the Day of Judgment) which will be at the time of the end. Most Bible scholars believe we are in that period now. This would explain why the crimes committed in this generation, (i.e., within the last 100 years) against humanity and our environment including our atmospheric, terrestrial, and aquatic environments and nature itself, have exceeded anything that has been done in previous generations. Interestingly in several

unauthorized versions of the Gospels, this was predicted to happen on the last day (see Humane Gospel of Christ and Gospel of the Holy Twelve).

Ninth, regeneration allows the continuance of what we sow and reap

We must accept that whatever events we experience in this life is the direct result of something that we initiated in our own past. The conditions under which we are born are directly related to what we have accomplished in our own previous lives. In the words of the Church Father Origen: "Every soul... comes into this world strengthened by the victories or weakened by the defeats of its previous life" (Origen, De Principiis). But more than this what I had said at the beginning of a man enjoying the fruits of his labors; his inheritance is guaranteed under the law of regeneration. Under our present religious regime, the accumulation of wealth has no purpose, the message is; 'you cannot take it with you to Heaven, therefore, leave it to us.' With the accumulation of wealth comes the responsibility to our fellow angels as no one is an island in regeneration.

We spend all our working life accumulating possessions that someone else is going to enjoy since all of Adam's descendants must die. Does this sound right to you? As King Solomon wisely said this is "vanity of vanity" (Ecclesiastes 1:1-4). Many preachers make the mistake of interpreting these words of Solomon to mean that accumulating wealth is vanity, but that is not what Solomon is saying. Candidly speaking, he is saying that if this is the system that I work, gather, and die then someone else enjoys the fruit of my labors then excuse me it is an awful disappointment! That is why it is pure vanity:

"I made me great works, I built me houses, I planted me vineyards, I made me gardens and parks, and I planted trees in them, of all kinds of fruit. I made me pools of water, to water therefrom the wood springing up with trees; I acquired menservants and maidservants and had servants born in my house. Also, I had great possessions of herds and flocks, above all that were before me in Yerushalayim.... And I hated all my labor wherein I labored under the sun, seeing that I must leave it unto the man that shall be after me. And who knows whether he will be a wise man or a fool? Yet will he have rule over all my labor wherein I have labored, and wherein I have shown myself wise under the sun. This also is vanity. Therefore I turned about to cause my heart to despair, concerning all the labor wherein I had labored under the sun. For there is a man whose labor is with wisdom, and with knowledge, and with skill: yet to a man that has not labored therein, shall he leave it for his portion. This also is vanity and

a great evil. For what has a man of all his labor, and of the striving of his heart, wherein he labors under the sun? (Ecclesiastes 2:4-7; 18-21 NKJV).

This is not how God designed the system; we are supposed to enjoy the fruits of our labor forever. What you accumulate in one lifetime should be available to you in the next for your pleasure and personal advancement after all you did earn it. We forfeit the right to succession of wealth when we use it for evil and destruction. With much wealth comes the responsibility to help our fellow man and that is the real purpose of wealth. Then there is the other positive side to this - it is also about continuing the enjoyment of family and friends. When we have the knowledge of our loved ones being reborn, we can celebrate their new beginning. We can continue the relationship right where we left off, except of course it is prohibited in matrimonial situations where the age cap is formidable.

Queen Victoria of England is rumored to have said on her deathbed that she would give up to half of her kingdom to lengthen her days. What if she had known the truth, she would have instead rejoiced in her next appointment. The truth is we don't need to give anything to elongate our life or even entertain the idea because we can't ever beat the system! God designed it that way, and you cannot change His design - the encryption is unbreakable, and the circumstances are beyond our control. Nature and her cycles are here to stay. We are like a tree. Every tree starts from a seed and eventually returns to being a seed. Take for instance a fruit tree; when a fruit tree reaches its maximum life span of normally 50-80 years, you need to replant seed from that fruit tree to continue to enjoy the fresh fruits it produces; on and on the cycle goes as long as there is an Earth. So it is with regeneration.

Tenth, regeneration enables the propagation of the Torah and the Gospel to "the ends of the Earth."

If regeneration were not a reality, then the fulfillment of the prophetic commandment for the propagation of the Torah and the Gospel to "the ends of the Earth" would be problematic. I make no apology for this fact if you are an atheist or agnostic or of some other religious persuasion that does not believe in the Torah and the Good News which are part and parcel of the law of regeneration. The Torah is not a religion; also, the Law of Moses was not given to man as an option to consider. The Torah was given to man as the way of life to be followed. It is by following the Torah and the Scriptures that we eventually can return to the home from whence we originally came. What if I am of

another religion? You can observe the Torah now or wait for regeneration. Either way, you will be confronted with the Torah.

When the children of Yisra'el were given the Torah at Mount Sinai, YHWH set them apart to be a Kingdom of priests and kings. They were given the ominous task of teaching the nations and leading the nations into the one true worship of the One true Creator. It was a tremendous responsibility and task. A task that Yisra'el could not complete due to a divided household, despite King David's efforts to unify the Kingdom. The responsibility to teach the Torah and Worship of YHWH would fall on the disciples of Yeshua, and if regeneration were not a reality, they would not be able to complete this mammoth task.

The way that Acts 1:8 is worded shows that Yeshua understood that the same people who stood before Him when He gave this commission would, in turn, preach the message of the Torah and Good News to the ends of the Earth. Notice the word YOU as highlighted in this passage.

"But when the Ruach HaKodesh comes upon **you**, **you** will receive power: and **you** will be witnesses for Me in Yerushalayim, and in all Y'hudah, and also among the Samaritans; even unto the ends of the Earth." (My emphasis in bold).

This is a perpetual, prophetic commandment! The same people who were commissioned here were to preach the Gospel until it reaches the end of the Earth - where the "preaching" includes the translations and the printing of Scripture. It finally took 2,000 years to reach the ends of the Earth! In 2008 I attended an All Nations' Prayer Assembly in Tahiti to mark the completion of the propagation of the gospel to "the ends of the Earth." Tahiti was the point from where the final move of preaching the gospel to the Islands was initiated in the 1800s.

This explains why certain outstanding individuals in history possessed a relentless drive and determination in the face of danger, torture, and death to accomplish the commission. They include John Calvin, John Knox, Ulrich Zwingli, Martin Luther, William Tyndale, John Bunyan, Jonathan Edwards, George Whitefield, William Wilberforce, John Wesley, David Livingston, Richard Allen, Charles Finney, Charles Spurgeon, John Henry Newman, John Williams, and others, too many to name here. Many of them are still among us, extending the Torah and the Gospel to new frontiers.

Eleventh, regeneration allows for the correction of the soul

My major concern with the knowledge of knowing our past and future was that it might upset what God purposed for us to learn from

our past experiences. I remind myself that this system has been in operation from the beginning of time! If we were to calculate a regeneration system - for instance, a 70-year lifespan over the biblical six-thousand-year time frame, then that would be around 85 regenerations or generations! The truth is most people have experienced more than 100 regenerations because in some generations people will die early. The question that begs us to ask here, is how many times does one need to be reborn to learn the same lesson? What if you could know those mistakes - would you repeat them?

The reason why people go to school is to hopefully learn not to make the same mistake as their ancestors; at least that is why we learn history as a subject. But does history need to repeat itself constantly rehearsing the same conclusion? Regeneration is not so that we can learn our lessons again and again, but so that we can learn to do good and better than our previous existence. For example, if a man is a gifted carpenter in one cycle, why can't he learn in the next life to become an architect or an engineer? How can he possibly expand the gift for which he was born if he became a beggar instead? Instead, history has taught us that man is stuck in a cycle of repeating mistakes yet his calling and gift do not change. Roman 11:29 says, 'for the gifts and callings of God are irrevocable.' Meaning they don't get extinguished at death.

This is why we can never run away from our gift and calling, it will always return to us and the longer we fight it, the more it will haunt us. It is the same with vowels we have made with YHWH; they cannot cease at death. Vowels between men cease at death although that changes when the name of God is invoked in the vowel. For instance, the covenant between David and Jonathan is irrevocable because they swore before YHWH (1 Samuel 18:1, 20:16) therefore, it continues onto successive regenerations in the same persons when they are reborn. It will cease to be so when both parties re-invoke the Sacred Name to cancel the oath.

If you are like me having passed the halfway mark in life, you should have matured in your character and realized the lessons of our cycles. In every cycle, the Almighty (the Fore-Father) continues to ask the obvious questions: When will this son of mine come to his senses? When will he learn to do good? How much longer do I have to wait? What more do I have to do? In the forbearance and the foreknowledge of the Fore-Father "He" already knows the answers to these difficult questions, yet "He" allows us the free will to make our own choices, knowing that these choices will lead us away from home. But the time has arrived for the prodigal son to return home and is he or she ready?

Twelfth, regeneration allows for the education of the soul

The idea that regeneration occurs because of the education of the soul is found in every religion that believes in reincarnation. The statement is made in religion that, reincarnation occurs because we have so much to learn and the short life we experience is not enough time to learn these lessons on love, compassion, non-violence, patience, and all the other issues that would benefit our soul. Who can argue with that, I agree no one lifetime can be ever sufficient to perfect what we call the human character. In Chapter 9 (Home) this topic is discussed in detail so I will bypass it here.

This Earth is a classroom so to speak that was designed to allow for the education of the soul. In any one semester on this Earth (represented by one regeneration cycle) we can only learn at best to master one or two virtues, and sadly many fail to master a single virtue and must do so over many lifetimes. The discipline of Theology and Philosophy combined tell us that there are seven theological virtues. I quote from Wikipedia;

"In the Catholic catechism, the Seven Christian Virtues refers to the union of two sets of virtues. The four Cardinal virtues, from ancient Greek philosophy, are **Prudence**, **Justice**, **Temperance** (or **Restraint**), and **Courage** (or **Fortitude**). The three Theological virtues, from the letters of St. Paul of Tarsus, are **Faith**, **Hope**, and **Charity** (or **Love**). These were adopted by the Church Fathers as the Seven Virtues. The first virtues were identified by the Greek philosopher Aristotle and Plato, who regarded Temperance, Wisdom, Justice, and Courage as the four most desirable character traits. After the New Testament was written, these four virtues became known as the Cardinal virtues, while Faith, Hope, and Charity were referred to as the Theological virtues." (My emphasis in bold).

Later another seven were added to the list;

"A list of the Seven heavenly virtues - to oppose the Seven deadly sins-appeared later, in an epic poem entitled Psychomachia, or Battle/Contest of the Soul. Written by Aurelius Clemens Prudentius, a Christian governor, who died around 410 A.D., it entails the battle between good virtues and evil vices. The enormous popularity of this work in the Middle Ages helped to spread the concept of holy virtue throughout Europe. The virtues are identified as Chastity, Temperance, Charity, Diligence, Patience, Kindness, and Humility. Practicing them is said to protect one against temptation from the Seven deadly sins, each one having its counterpart. Due to this, they are

sometimes referred to as the "Contrary Virtues" Wikipedia. (My emphasis in bold).

These fourteen virtues are missing one very important virtue, which I would like to add here from the Torah; *Obedience*. This is often the hardest to master. Until the soul has mastered the fifteen virtues, I am afraid the cycles cannot end. Thankfully, however, the age of the Kingdom will allow us to accelerate this process.

Thirteenth, regeneration allows the reunification of souls

Another purpose for regeneration is to allow us to be reunited with our soul mates or our opposite charges. When our first prime-mate was created, it is said in the book of Genesis that YHWH took a sample of Adam's side and created Chavah (Eve), and brought her to the man to be his wife. On the surface, this union appears to be just in the flesh, but in reality, it was the uniting of two opposite charges to create the foundation for life. Remember at the core of our being we are pure energy and the male is always a positive charge and the female a negative charge. However, what is generally not known is that there is a necessary ground charge that completes the circuit of the soul. This was the woman Lilith Whom God created as Adam's first wife.

Yes, Adam had two wives who were his soul mates. For the purpose of illustration, we can see this truth in the configuration of an electrical delivery system where we have a positive, a negative, and a neutral (Earth or ground). It takes three dissimilarly charged entities to establish an effective arrangement in the electrical world. Without any of the three charges, you will have an incomplete circuit or unsafe connection. Likewise, the principle is the same as the soul of a man. A male with his positive charge needs his opposites, a negative and a ground, to be whole. We see this truth alluded to in Scripture where it says that "a threefold cord is not quickly broken" (Ecclesiastes 4:12).

You will not find Lilith directly mentioned in the creation story of Genesis, but she is clearly there between the lines of Genesis. When YHWH created Adam in His image the way that the text is worded in Genesis shows that YHWH created man in a <u>pair</u> on the <u>same day</u> as He did with all of His other creations - both male (positive) and female (negative) on the same day - in this case on the sixth day (Genesis 1:31), then Elohim rested on the Seventh day. Adam's union with his first wife resulted in the birth of Shet* who also had two wives:

"This is the book of the generations of Adam, in the day that Elohim created man. In the likeness of Elohim made He him; Male and female

created He them, and blessed them, and called their name Adam, in the (SAME) day when they were created. And Adam lived a hundred and thirty years and begot a son in his own likeness, after his image, and called his name Shet" (Genesis 5:1-3).

(*Genesis 5:5-6 mentions that Seth had more children later, most likely from (an) other women he later married owing to the long duration of his lifespan - 912 years!)

In the case of Chavah, the text indicates that she was created later, most likely on the Shabbat or the seventh day. This time YHWH created Chavah from the flesh of Adam, and it was during his Shabbat sleep; a great thing for Adam because when He awoke on the first day of the week, YHWH brought Him his new wife. According to Jewish teaching, Lilith left the garden due to a dispute she had with her husband, and she made her abode outside of the garden. The story goes like this:

"After YHWH created Adam, who was alone, He said, 'It is not good for man to be alone.' He then created a woman for Adam, from the Earth, as He had created Adam himself, and called her Lilith. Adam and Lilith immediately began to fight. She said, 'I will not lie below,' and he said, 'I will not lie beneath you, but only on top. For you are fit only to be in the bottom position, while I am to be the superior one.' Lilith responded, 'We are equal to each other inasmuch as we were both created from the Earth on the same sixth day.' But they would not listen to one another. When Lilith saw this, she pronounced the Ineffable Name YHWH and flew away into the air."

Interestingly there is also a Christian tradition of the story of Lilith. The meaning of the name Lilith is apparent in Isaiah 34:14 where it is translated as a night creature or monster because she gave into her evil inclination and refused to return to Adam. This explains why in Genesis 3:16 YHWH suddenly warns Chavah not to control, manipulate and emaciate the man – i.e., a warning not to follow in the ways of Lilith, Adam's first wife. Lilith after she had left the garden had many lovers (Satan and the fallen angels) and begat demons or evil spirits. The fallen angels are not demon spirits, but some animals take on the spirit of demons.

The point of this revelation is not to promote polygamy, but to explain that regeneration allows us to reconnect with our opposite charges (pair) after they have been regenerated. The way that the system works, very often not all three soul mates are alive at the same time, but should they be; it can explain why men in many countries marry more than one wife or divorce to remarry again. We cannot ignore the fact that almost all of the patriarchs had more than one wife - usually

two. Perhaps the best example is Jacob and his two wives - Rachel and Leah. See our teaching letter on Patriarchal Marriage ISSUE 11 for more information on this topic.

Fourteenth - Other Purposes

We can also learn from other religions why regeneration is a reality. As previously mentioned, I don't accept the doctrine of reincarnation that is taught by Hinduism or for that matter Buddhism; however, it does not mean that they have not got some of the fundamentals of regeneration correct. It is, in fact, these fundamentals that are at the core of this system that makes regeneration of perfect sense. I want to share with you some of the others reasons, why Hindus believe in reincarnation and then why Buddhists believe in reincarnation.

Hindus provide several reasons why the soul (*jiva*) takes on various physical bodies:

- To experience the fruits of one's karma: (see below for definition of karma) This is the main reason for rebirth. Sattvika, the good or righteous karmas reward one with the pleasures of Svarga, the highest heaven. Rajas, the pleasure-seeking karmas, reward one with mrutyuloka or Earth, the mortal realm. And Tamas karmas related to actions involving inertia, laziness, and evil condemns one to patalaloka, the lowest underworld.
- 2. To satisfy one's desires: When a person indulges in material pleasures, he or she subsequently develops a stronger desire to enjoy more of it (Vāsanā). This unending craving to satisfy one's desires causes the jiva (soul) to assume new physical bodies.
- To complete one's unfinished sadhana (journey): When an aspirant making spiritual efforts for liberation from maya (illusive reality) dies without attaining his or her goal, the jiva gets, as a result of the natural cause-effect phenomenon, another human body to complete its sadhana.
- 4. To fulfill a debt: When a *jiva* is indebted to another *jiva*, it gets a human birth to fulfil its debt, and the creditor gets a human birth as well to receive what is owed to it. The *jiva* comes in the form of a relative, friend, or an enemy.
- 5. To undergo sufferings because of a great soul's curse: A person's grave error or sin may incur the wrath or displeasure of God or a *Rishi*. This results in the *jiva* of that person getting another birth, not necessarily into a human body.

6. To attain *moksha*, the liberation from rebirth or *samsara*: By the grace and compassion of God or a God-realized guru, a *jiva* gets a human body to purge itself of the layers of base instincts. Source *Wikipedia*.

Definition of karma: As the soul moves from one body to another, it carries along with it an account of the effects of the various deeds it has performed. This can be thought of as a global account that each soul is associated with, irrespective of the place it is in currently. This account would have both the logs of the good and bad deeds it performed - similar to the credits and liabilities of a business operation. This account is what is called karma.

Below is a description that Buddhism offers of reincarnation:

"When we die, the mind, with all the tendencies, preferences, abilities, and characteristics that have been developed and conditioned in this life, re-establishes itself in a fertilized egg. Thus the individual grows, is reborn, and develops a personality conditioned both by the mental characteristics that have been carried over and by the new environment. The personality will change and be modified by conscious effort; and conditioning factors like education, parental influence, and society and once again at death, re-establishing itself in a new fertilized egg. This process of dying and being reborn will continue until the conditions that cause it, craving and ignorance, cease. When they do, instead of being reborn, the mind attains a state called Nirvana, and this is the ultimate goal of Buddhism and the purpose of life." http://www.buddhanet.net/elearning/history/b_faqs.htm.

- 14. Fourteenth the other purpose of regeneration is the law of karma.

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
