WHO GAVE YOU THE RIGHT TO EDIT THE BIBLE? Recently, a sincere believer and one of many told me that the Torah of Moshe has been fulfilled in the death and resurrection of Yeshua; therefore, we do not have to obey the Old Testament Commandments. I'm not particularly eager to educate a fool. I replied with one statement and demanded a straight answer: "Who gave you the right to edit the Bible?" The question made them think. I now pose the same question to humanity. Please show me where Elohim states that the Torah is no longer valid or that parts have been superseded. There is not one verse anywhere that says this. We have no right to add or remove anything from the Scripture; the Word condemns this practice. Should anyone tell me that the New Testament Scriptures have replaced the Old, that person does not know Elohim or their Bible. Our right lies only in determining their proper or correct meaning if it has been mistranslated from their original languages. I have spent decades of my life studying the mistranslation issues in the Scriptures, which are appalling and shameful to the learned. I don't have room here to explain the thousands of mistakes. I am one of hundreds of Scholars who know these mistakes and have written about them. Now, why is it very wrong/evil to edit the Bible? There are quickly five reasons. 1) The TaNaK (the Hebrew Scriptures) and the Brit Chadashah (the Renewed Covenant) are divine documents or revelations. They did not come from man, although men were used to bring it to us. 2) The Word is eternal, meaning forever; it will hold true from generation to generation because its origin precedes the start of time itself. 3) Elohim does not change. He is the same yesterday, today, and forever. He is not a man who lies and changes their mind. 4) Elohim does not repent. He will not apologize to humanity for His decisions. He will not repeal a commandment He has spoken no matter how unpopular it is to a generation. 5) The Scriptures cannot be broken. Nothing in the New must destroy the Old. If there are conflicts, then they are scribal mistakes/errors/altercations or translation issues. These five reasons should send shivers to these butchers who love to carve the Word and serve people with their own creation. I am warning these persons now to stop this nonsense or face the coming judgment! Many who are unsatisfied with my answer will resort to the second condemnation: it is impossible to keep these laws. Who said so? I have kept them faithfully for over 30 years and have only experienced blessing and abundance. My failure or weakness to obey His Commandments is where I have faltered. Still, my simple answers are not sufficient, so they ask. Do you sacrifice animals and perform other temple requirements? The answer is no because we have no Temple or Priesthood; therefore, we can safely leave these things aside. It is the Messiah who will clarify these issues when he returns. Until Shiloh appears, we can comfortably practice the commandments and leave the problematic things aside. Still, others will tell me, what about the death of Yeshua? Has this not rendered the sacrifices obsolete? Yeshua's sacrifice does not render anything obsolete in Elohim's Word. Where there is transgression of the commandments, a sacrifice is required according to the Law. The difference is that we now have a better sacrifice because Yeshua has become our ultimate atonement. However, that does not render the priesthood and the Temple obsolete or any other Commandment. The Word is Holy, Pure, and Just. If the Messiah were here to answer these questions, he too would uphold the Written Torah without compromise as he did in his time. Our persistence to edit the Word is why evil grows and spreads like cancer in the World and why His people live defeated or impoverished lives. The slippery slope down goes like this. 'If we can weaken the foundation, we can bring in all sorts of false narratives and alternative views of reality. We can then question many things in the Word of Elohim and introduce heresies and abominations. We can create thousands of religions based on these alternative beliefs. Thus, evil says we can defeat them.' The slide down began by tampering with the Word of Elohim. Let me ask you, what is wrong with accepting the Words of Elohim as they are? Do we need to reason out everything first, as the Greeks and the Romans would have us believe? No, we don't. Obey the Word, and everything will start to make sense! Allow Him to reveal His Word to us.
