

WHY ME? This will make sense as you read through, and the revelation will either shock you or heal you. Devarim (Deuteronomy) 29 "12 That you should enter into brit (Covenant) with YHWH your Elohim, and into His oath, which YHWH your Elohim makes with you this day: 13 That He may establish you today for a people to Himself, and that He may be to you an Elohim, as He has said to you, and as He has sworn to your ahvot (fathers), to Avraham, to Yitzchak, and to Yaakov.14 Neither with you only do I make this brit (Covenant) and this oath;15 But with him that stands here with us this day before YHWH our Elohim, and also with him that is not here with us this day:" Note the last part "and also with him that is not here with us this day." And they replied before Moses that they will do it. Now who is "the him who is not here." This is the secret of the Covent mentioned in Psalm 25:14 that I am now showing you. We were never allowed to choose our Elohim or what book we could follow. Your forefathers in the Hebrew faith made your fathers swear all their generations to YHWH long before there was a Jewish, Christian, or Muslim faith. How many people eventually came out of the Hebrew clan? You have guessed it, billions of people! Like the stars and sands uncountable. The truth is this: we are like our own children; we did not choose our "God" or religion; it was made for us by our parents! You can kick up a stink all you like, but it changes nothing according to the laws of Elohim. The light of His Kingdom is in you already. But here is the interesting part.
