THE RE-BOUNDARIES: The Earth will be restructured over time as part of the restoration process of the Kingdom of Elohim on Earth. It has begun. Since the fall of Adam, powers, authorities, and rulers have unlawfully claimed dominion over regions and nations. According to YHWH's mandate in the book of Genesis, the Earth was divided into 70 nations after the Deluge (Beresheeth (Genesis) 10:25), based on the languages of Noah's descendants. Various Jewish traditions support the concept of 70 nations. The Talmud and Midrash, for instance, mention the "70 languages." The Talmud states that when G-d gave the Torah on Mount Sinai, it was spoken in 70 languages (Talmud, Shabbat 88b), and Moses translated the Torah into these languages before his death (Talmud, Sotah 32a). This idea is also inferred from the biblical account. Following the genealogies of Noah's descendants, the Bible narrates the incident of the Tower of Babel: "Now the entire earth was of one language and uniform words... And they said, 'Come, let us build ourselves a city and a tower with its top in the heavens...' And the L-rd said, 'Lo! (They are) one people and they all have one language... Come, let us descend and confuse their language so that one will not understand the language of his companion.' And the L-rd scattered them from there upon the face of the entire earth, and they ceased building the city" (Genesis 11:1-8). The Torah lists 70 descendants of Noah immediately before this event, suggesting that each of these descendants became the progenitor of a nation with its own language. Later, in the book of Deuteronomy, YHWH reveals that this division of nations was aligned with the number of the heavenly messengers overseeing the regions: "*When Elyon apportioned the nations their inheritance, when He separated the sons of Adam, He set the boundaries of the peoples according to the number of the heavenly messengers of Elohim*" (Devarim (Deuteronomy) 32:8). Today, the world is divided into nearly 200 nations, many of which were established based on military, political, or religious motives. However, these divisions are human constructs. In the time of the coming Kingdom, these artificial boundaries will be undone, and the Earth will return to its original division of 70 nations in accordance with the Divine Order. Here are the combinations of nations according to their regions: Note: These nations will combine to form one country each and a referendum will be made to decide on a name.

YHWH did not endorse the division of the Earth into 195 countries; this fragmentation reflects the work of ha-Satan. In the Kingdom to come, these divisions will be dismantled, restoring the Earth to its intended state under Divine governance. This year marks the beginning of the dethronement of these powers. Religions, organizations, institutions, societies, alliances, governments, municipalities, influential elites, and the super-wealthy—all of which sustain these divisions—are facing a divine audit in the years ahead. Their artificial boundaries and oppressive systems will be exposed and dismantled, clearing the path for humanity's progression into a new era. The current order, rooted in the worship of Baal, cannot continue into the Millennium. Baal, whose name derives from a Semitic root meaning "lord" or "master," was revered in Canaanite and other Near Eastern traditions as a supreme deity—none other than Lucifer. As the god of division, apostasy, and abominations, Baal has opposed YHWH's divine order from the beginning. Prophets like Eliyahu (Elijah) stood against Baal worship, exemplified in the dramatic confrontation on Mount Carmel (1 Kings 18), where Elijah challenged the prophets of Baal to demonstrate their deity's power. The fall of Adam allowed Baal's power and principality to dominate humanity, but this dominion was temporary. As Moses taught, it will end when Shiloh comes. Jacob's blessing to Judah declares: *"The scepter shall not depart from Judah, nor the ruler's staff from between his feet, until Shiloh comes; and to him shall be the obedience of the peoples"* Beresheeth (Genesis) 49:10. With the advent of the Millennium, YHWH's order will require that Satan is bound for a thousand years (Gilyahna (Revelation) 20:2-3). The forces restraining the order of the Kingdom will soon be subdued. The restructuring of the Earth is rooted in four divine principles: 1. The Earth was initially divided into 70 nations. 2. Seventy symbolizes perfection and the law of Elohim. 3. Seventy melechim (kings) were appointed to govern the Earth's regions. 4. Peace, progress, and prosperity were guaranteed to flow under this order. We have nothing to fear from obeying His directives. Our fear of this divine governance stems from a lack of understanding of how the Kingdom operates. Humanity has created various governmental divisions—executive, legislative, judiciary, and new territories—to maintain order, peace, and security. These structures embody a principle of governance that Yeshua himself affirmed. On his final night, Yeshua assured his disciples that they would sit on 12 thrones, judging the 12 tribes of Yisra'el (Luka (Luke) 22:29-30). This indicates that 58 additional righteous kings will need to be appointed to fulfill the divine order of Earth's governance. That appointed season has now arrived. The Master will Himself confirm these people.
